The programme in a nutshell

- 60 ECTS Advanced Master degree
- Evening classes (6-9 PM) – ideal for professionals
- Full-time (1y) and part-time (2y) track

- 6 different specialisation combinations (chosen combination of 2 policy fields will be mentioned on your degree)
- Interdisciplinary programme organised by a Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence on the doorstep of the main EU institutions

Who can apply?

To qualify for admission you need to have:

- a university degree equivalent to a Master's degree (preferably in social, economic or political sciences, business, law, or contemporary history)
- excellent academic results and references
- proven proficiency in English

What does it cost?

The Programme offers a limited number of scholarships, that take the form of partial tuition waivers. These waivers are awarded on the basis of a separate request, submitted as a part of your application. They are awarded upon an assessment of merit and demonstrable need.

What can you study?

After the 4 mandatory courses (21 credits), students take 2 pre-selected specialisation options (24 credits), to be chosen from the list of 4 below. You close off the programme with a Master's thesis (15 credits).
